About This Resource

This resource contains 24 questions design to help students reflect on their school year. The questions can be used as conversation starters or writing prompts.

Ways to Use the Conversation Starter Cards

Partners

A group of two takes turns reading the questions and answering.

Small Groups

1 person reads a question card, then the rest of the group answers. The person who reads rotates through the group.

Whole Class

Ask 1 question per day during a morning meeting or other specific time to encourage the whole class to engage in reflection.

Ways to Use the Writing Prompts

There are 24 pages of writing prompts that includes space to write and draw their response. You can give the prompts as homework, bell work, daily practice, writing centers. There are enough prompts to give 1 prompt a day for the final month of school. Or the students can select which prompt they would like to answer.

This single page list is tailored to give to older students to digitally write their responses.
